Information from the Data Administrator regarding the processing of personal data for the purposes of organising the 6th Polish Congress of Mechanics and 27th International Conference on Computer Methods in Mechanics (<https://pcm-cmm.com/>) – in accordance with Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the GDPR)

1. The controller of your personal data is the Polish Society for Theoretical and Applied Mechanics, Białystok branch, Wiejska 45C Str., 15-351 Białystok, Poland.
2. Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
 - a) participation in the conference, including in particular for the purposes of participant registration, organisation, conduct and proper settlement of the conference – pursuant to Article 6(1)(b), (c) and (f) of the GDPR;
 - b) documenting the course of the conference for information and promotional purposes and to produce a report on the conference pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR and the consent given – Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.
3. The recipients of your personal data may include entities providing IT and hosting services to the Controller, entities processing data on the basis of data processing agreements in accordance with Article 28 of the GDPR, and other entities authorised under the law.
4. Your personal data will be retained for the periods necessary to fulfil the purposes set out above and for the period required by law regarding archiving.
5. You have the right to access your personal data, and, subject to the provisions of the law, you have the right to:
 - a) rectify your data,
 - b) erase your data,
 - c) restrict the processing of your data,
 - d) data portability,
 - e) object to the processing of your personal data,
6. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority – the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection – if you consider that the processing of your personal data infringes the applicable legislation in this regard.
7. The provision of personal data is voluntary, but it is necessary in order to take part in the conference and you are obliged to provide it. Failure to provide such data will result in you being unable to take part in the conference.
8. The data controller does not process the personal data provided by means of automated decision-making, including profiling.
